City Council Meeting Highlights from 11/25/24

The Council welcomed residents from S. Elm to discuss the possibility of a speed bump being placed on their street.

In listening to the public, the Council has decided to pursue other avenues of traffic control for S. Elm and not to put in a speed bump. The City thanks everyone who came and took part in the discussion.

- Jessica Bowman expressed her willingness to help whoever may take over the Animal Control Officer position for Whitewater and presented many ways to help the cat population in and around Whitewater. Whitewater KS Community Cats Inc., Paws in Oz, Alley Cat Allies, etc.
- Council approved job descriptions developed for both the Animal Control Officer and Zoning Administrator/Code Enforcement Officer roles.
- The November Financial Report was approved by the Council with a request to see what Whitewater has received from Sales Tax at the December meeting.
- The water tower maintenance has been completed and went well.
- The middle school did their Rake & Run again and helped gather so many leaves that the city maintenance offered to help with their dump trailer. There is a nice sized pile of leaves at the dump thanks to these kiddos and their teachers.
- There have been a few water leaks as well as hydrant leaks that the Maintenance crew have and will be working towards fixing. They thank you for your understanding and patience as they fix issues that pop up around town.
- A reminder to all, the speed limit within the city limits of Whitewater is 20MPH, please help remind everyone. Signs are posted.
- The Council has approved the purchase of a new mower for the upcoming mowing season.
- The start of an official Policy & Procedure Handbook has been approved by the City Council. These policies will take effect January 1, 2025.
- According to City Ordinance 636 passed in 2022, the rates for trash will increase in the year 2025.

All are welcome at City Council meetings. Public Comment time is available; with a 5 minute limit per person near the beginning of each meeting. To discuss a specific topic, please contact the City Clerk to be placed on the agenda.


