

Leaves and grass clippings are to be put on the compost pile. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

City Code: Article 2. Fire Prevention 7-204. OPEN BURNING.

a) It shall be unlawful for any person to burn trash, rubbish, leaves, straw, grass or other combustible material in any public grounds of the city, or to burn the same in any concrete gutter or on any street or alley improved by concrete or brick or asphaltic pavement or by petroleum products.

b) It shall be unlawful for any person to burn any trash, leaves, lumber, straw, paper, boxes, grass or other combustible materials openly within the fire limits of the city.

c) Burning of combustible materials may be authorized by issuance of a burning permit with conditions and restrictions stated thereon as determined by the Chief of the Fire Department, his or her representative or authorized agents, where the reduction or disposal of such solid waste and where such burning would not be in conflict with state regulations. It shall be prima facie evidence that the person who owns or controls property on which burning occurs has caused or permitted the fire. (Ord. 447, Sec. 1)



Whitewater River Consolidated Fire District



The Whitewater River CFD responded to 9 calls for service in the month of October. They included 5 medical calls, 3 vehicle accidents and a grass fire in our response area. One of the accidents at NW 150th Street and Butler Road involved the Whitewater River CFD, Butler County EMS, Newton Fire/EMS and EagleMed.

The Whitewater River Consolidated Fire District was involved in several activities on October 7th at the Frederic Remington Festival. We had several trucks in the parade, opened our door after the parade for visitors to see some of our equipment, CPR/AED Training, water games, provided medical standby at the ATV Rodeo and assisted with the fireworks display. Our First Responders also responded to two medical calls during the day's events.

As most know, the Butler County portion of the Whitewater River Consolidated Fire District, including Whitewater and Elbing will soon be receiving ambulance coverage from Butler County EMS. The cities of Whitewater and Elbing along with Milton and Fairmount Townships have contracted with Newton Fire/ EMS for ambulance coverage for the past several decades. Due to events out of our control, the Butler County side of the fire district will fall back under Butler County EMS' response area.

The Whitewater River Consolidated Fire District has been diligently working on several issues to hopefully make the change over as smooth as possible on January 1, 2024. The Fire District has received new pagers, purchased with grant monies so we can receive pager notification from both Harvey and Butler County 911 Centers. Butler County EMS has also been providing our personnel with some medical training and some additional training for our EMTs and First Responders.

Butler County EMS Director Frank Williams was present at the Whitewater City Council Meeting on October 23rd to update the Council about the upcoming changes. Director Williams reported that we could see Butler County Ambulances driving through our Fire District occasionally prior to January 1 so the crews can get familiarized with the area. He also gave an update from Butler County 911 Communications at the request of Director Seglem who couldn't attend the meeting. The update included adding the response area information for Whitewater's Fire District and the ability to page WRCFD to their system.

Director Williams also mentioned Director Seglem wanted him to mention the "Reverse 911" System. The self-registration web address is: https://www.bucoks.com/205/Reverse-9-1-1-Self-Registration. By registering your phone number, Butler County 911 can send mass messages to your phone to alert you in case of emergencies in your immediate area. This service is used throughout the county for missing children, manhunts and other emergency situations when the public needs to know about their safety. The dispatcher can select a specific area that is affected and only send the alert to the phones registered in that area rather than county wide.

Our Facebook Page has moved and can be found by searching Whitewater Fire Department.

If you (male or female) are interested in volunteering a few hours a month, feel free to stop by the District Office, come to a fire drill or call (316) 799-2121 to see what it's all about. Our fire drills are the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month at 7pm, either at the District Office or the Whitewater Fire Station.
